

## *Rules for Alberta Breeder of the Year*

### Club Level

- 1) Nominations open from breeders through the local club
- 2) If no Nominees, club directors must come up with at least 3 nominees
- 3) Club Directors put together committee of 3 Scorers to place and score each breeder. Idea being each scorer looks into 1 herd and reports back to other 2 so all can score the information.
- 4) If after all 3 breeders are scored there is a tie, the 3 scorers will vote to break a tie.
- 5) One winner per club area will be nominated to go forward to provincials with the validated info on farm from the club level scorer.

### Provincial Level

- 1) There will be a committee formed of 5 scorers consisting of 1 scorer per club area from provincial board.
- 2) If provincial board member is up for nomination then member not eligible to score
- 3) If no rep on AHA board than one of previous 3 club level scorer will be asked to sit on committee
- 4) 5 Scorers bring forward info on breeder from their club area and each scorer scores the other 4 nominees from across the province.
- 5) If after all 5 breeders are scored there is a tie, the 5 scorers will vote to break a tie.
- 6) After the Provincial Breeder of the Year has been decided the score cards are to be destroyed
- 7) Any breeder is eligible every year.
- 8) Focus on Achievements in that year. November 15 – November 15
